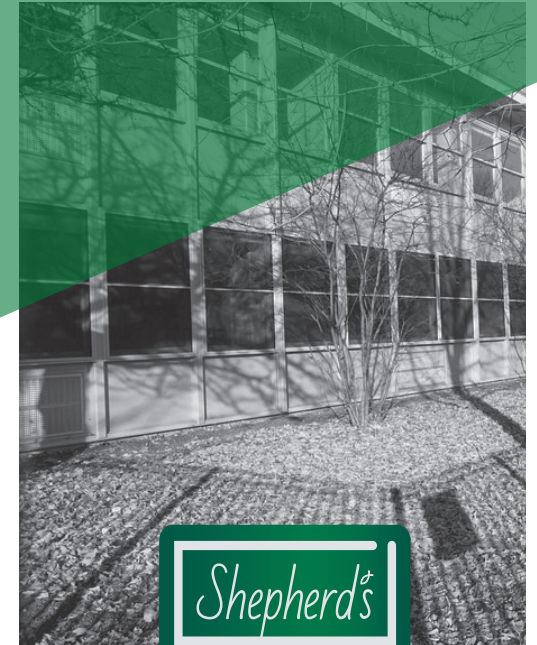

## WE NEED YOUR HELP

Since 2009, we have faithfully served this community, but we are out of space and we cannot complete the vision GOD set before us without a larger facility. GOD has now provided a building that will allow HIS plan to come to fruition.



## OUR GROWTH:

In 2015, Shepherd's HOPE and its ministry partners worked together to open the Family Feeding Center (at right) in a rented space about 5 blocks from the food pantry. Besides providing nutritious hot meals twice a week to about 250 guests, the staff of Shepherd's HOPE and the ministry partners love to build relationship with their guests, listening to their life stories while sharing their own life's journey and how the grace of **JESUS CHRIST** saved them.



## QUICK FACTS:

- We serve people from all backgrounds, primarily African-Americans, in need of a helping hand to survive in Chicago's Greater Englewood community.
- 9 million pounds of food have been distributed since we opened our Food Pantry (shown above) in 2009.
- 90,000 hot meals have been served since we opened The Family Feeding Center in 2015.
- 85,000 Volunteer hours have been donated (mostly by Englewood residents) since we began serving this Englewood community.

## OUR HISTORY:

Shepherd's HOPE was founded in 2008 by Brian Anderson following a call of God to physically and spiritually feed and care for the many homeless and poor he encountered in Chicago. The food pantry opened in 2009 in an Englewood bungalow, followed by neighborhood Bible studies, partnerships with other local ministries and businesses.

## OUR FUTURE:

In 2018, we will move into the much-needed larger facility formerly Mays Elementary School (shown above). In this nearly 50,000 sq ft facility, we will be able to bring our food pantry, family feeding center and 12 collaborative ministries together. We can't wait to see how the LORD is going to use this building.

## OUR NEEDS:

**\$350,000**

The cost to purchase, make the necessary renovations, and operate this 50,000 sq ft building for the first year is \$7/sq ft (an incredible value). We also will need volunteers to help with building renovation, and we welcome in-kind donations of materials and services that will reduce the cost of building repairs.
